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Timely Access for Vulnerable Communities

The need was to reduce risk and isolation for vulnerable communities by guaranteeing timely access to specialized diagnostic and reproductive healthcare services, without forcing women to undertake risky journeys into urban centres.

High-End Medical Infrastructure for Complex Territories

The challenge was to design and manufacture high-end medical infrastructure capable of continuous operation under extreme geographical conditions, marked by severely deteriorated road networks and complex public-order environments.

Mobile Gynecology, Mammography and Blood Donation Units

NINOX fully conceptualised and manufactured a Mobile Gynecology and Mammography Clinic and a mobile blood donation unit. Moving beyond the traditional model of purchasing costly generic imported solutions that often suffer structural failures in local topography, we applied co-design methods with local clinical staff to deliver robust units compliant with national and international healthcare authorisation standards.



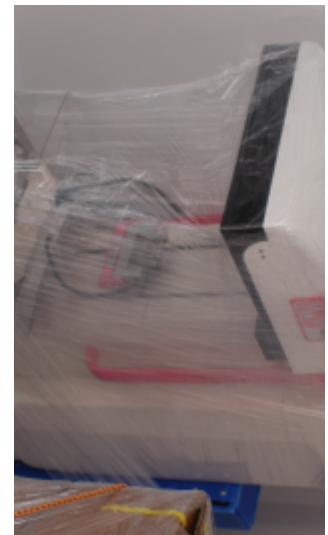
