Re-Engineering Critical Care Transport

The country required a complete re-engineering of critical care transport to enable the safe and timely transfer of highly complex patients whose survival depends on advanced external cardiac and respiratory support.

Colombia's First ECMO Ambulance

Designing Colombia's first ambulance with ECMO technology (extracorporeal membrane oxygenation) required the integration of a redundant stabilised power architecture and high-security structural anchoring for artificial lungs and hearts, within an environment of maximum spatial optimisation.

Advanced Support with Rigorous Clinical Ergonomics

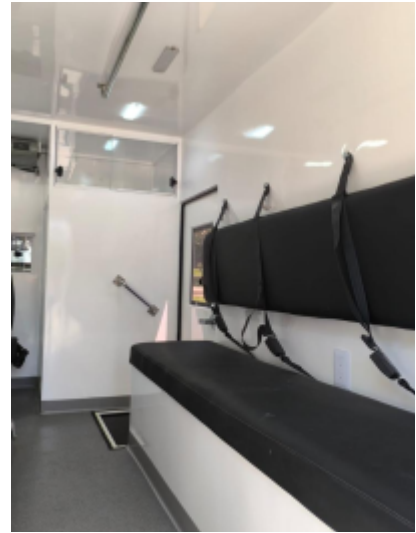
